Subject: Implementation of the Bhagat Puran Singh Sehat Bima Yojana - data of blue-card holder families.

In the meeting held with the Principal Secretary Health and Family Welfare on the directions of the Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister, Punjab, on 8.1.2014 for the implementation of the Bhagat Puran Singh Sehat Bima Yojnana (BPSSBY), it was decided as under:

1. It was pointed out that the data of the blue-card holder families provided by the Department of Food has lot of discrepancies and in order to ensure complete coverage of the blue-card holder families under this scheme, the Department of Food need to provide a complete data of these families. Since the Department of Food has taken a decision to distribute foodgrains to the blue-card holder families throughout the state through its own Food Inspectors as per the schedule to be finalized by the Department of Food, it was decided that this schedule shall be shared with the Punjab Health Systems Corporation so that the enrolment of these blue-card holder families could be carried out on the same day in the village/ town where foodgrains are going to be distributed by the Food Inspectors. This will also ensure authenticity of the data as Food Inspectors shall be present at these stations.
2. Punjab Health Systems Corporation through its shortlisted Insurance Companies shall carry out the enrolment process with the data provided by the Department of Food and while doing so if any blue-card holder come to the enrolment station with a blue-card and his/ her name does not find mention in the data provided by the

Department of Food, he/ she shall be enrolled and issued a smart card and the list of such enrolled beneficiaries at the stations shall be sent to the respective Food & Civil Supplies Controller for authentication.

It is, therefore, requested that these instructions may be forwarded to the field officers for meticulous compliance and the schedule of the distribution of foodgrains by the Food Inspectors may kindly be shared with the PHSC so that the insurance companies are advised to draw their route-plan for enrollment of beneficiaries accordingly.
