2. You are requested to start Internal Quality Assurance System in all Blood Banks to evaluate the working of the Blood Bank internally. The SMO, i/c along with BTO in charge would regularly evaluate the performance of Blood Bank. Hospital transfusion committee would once in a month evaluate the performance and propose improvements. The parameters for evaluation are placed as annexure-II.

3. The following number of MLTs may be available in the Blood Banks as per the total blood collection:

Monthly blood collection (units)	Blood component separator	No of MLTs
> 500	Available	8
300-500	Available	6
150-300	Available	4
<300	Not available	3

The Blood Banks having total blood collection of 500 units or more and where blood component separator is available, two staff nurses should be posted in the Blood Bank and in the rest of the Blood Banks, one staff nurse should be placed. In case of need of MLTs, a proposal may be sent to PHSC, HQ for outsourcing through user charges.

4. To organize voluntary blood donation camps, District Mass Media Officers should be contacted and their services utilized to organize camps with colleges, Universities, NGOs etc.
