Subject: To monitor the performance of Blood Banks in Punjab Health Systems Corporation hospitals.

With reference to the subject cited above, certain indicators are proposed to be evaluated monthly to analyze the performance of Blood Banks. These indicators are:

- Total blood collection
- Voluntary blood collection
- Blood component separation
- Blood donation camps

The targets of total blood collection are based on previous years' blood collection by Punjab State AIDS Control Society. PSACS has intimated the proposed collection for the year 2010-11. 75% of the proposed collection has to be through voluntary blood collection and for that voluntary blood collection camps have to be organized and the number of camps to be organized has been given by Punjab State AIDS Control Society. On the basis of the target received from Punjab State AIDS Control Society, monthly proposed total blood collection, monthly proposed voluntary blood collection through camps and monthly camps have been worked out and the details are placed as annexure -I.

Evaluation of the performance of the Blood Bank would be done as follows:-
